107. ADOPTION OF PLANNED INSTRUCTION	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 4.11</p>	<p>The Board shall provide a comprehensive program of planned instruction to enable district students to strive for academic goals and attain academic standards.</p> <p>Planned instruction shall consist of at least the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Objectives to be achieved by all students. 2. Content, including materials, activities and instructional time. 3. Relationship between objectives of a planned course and the established academic standards. 4. Procedure for measurement of the objective.
<p>2. Authority</p> <p>SC 508, 1511, 1512 Pol. 006</p>	<p>No planned instruction shall be taught in the schools of this district unless it has been adopted by a majority vote of the full Board. The Board reserves the right to determine which units of the instructional program constitute planned instruction and are subject to adoption by the Board.</p> <p>The Board subscribes to an instructional program and such planned instruction that will provide academic preparations for students to help them become competent individuals who will be prepared to assume a role in shaping the future.</p> <p>The curriculum offerings shall be in such quantity and quality so as to afford the balance that a student may wish to have in the pattern of instruction that s/he chooses.</p> <p>The Board accepts the premises that the school curriculum must be tailored to the student and that the instructional program shall be designed to fit the student's developing pattern of education.</p>
