<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Penn Manor School District values and recognizes the essential role that athletic activities play in the development of students, and the contributions of coaches, directors and students to the quality of Penn Manor's programs. The Board acknowledges that, in exceptional circumstances, it is appropriate to honor and perpetuate the memory of those individuals and teams who, through participation, support, or interest have made outstanding contributions to Penn Manor athletics, and who have helped to bring recognition, honor, distinction, or excellence to the Penn Manor School District and its interscholastic athletics program.</p>
<p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p><u>Committee</u> A committee shall be appointed to solicit and review nominations for athletic honors under this Policy, and organize and conduct induction ceremonies.</p> <p>The committee shall be composed of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Principal of the high school or his/her designee.2. Athletic Director.3. Board member appointed by the School Board for a two-year term.4. Two (2) current high school coaches (one male, one female) appointed by the coaches' council for overlapping two-year terms.5. Two (2) alumni (one male, one female) appointed by the alumni association for overlapping two-year terms.6. One (1) former varsity coach appointed by the Athletic Director for a two-year term. <p>The committee chairperson will be appointed by the Superintendent from the committee membership.</p> <p>Meetings shall be held at a minimum of one (1) per year and as business dictates.</p>

Eligibility

A person will be considered eligible for athletic honors if, at the time of nomination, s/he fulfills one of the following criteria:

1. Athlete – The individual participated in a varsity sport at Penn Manor. The time period since receiving his/her diploma from Penn Manor has been at least five (5) years.
2. Alumni – The individual has made an outstanding contribution or offered extraordinary service to athletics in the Penn Manor School District while attending Penn Manor High School or since leaving. The time period since receiving his/her diploma has been at least five (5) years.
3. Athletic Staff – The individual has made outstanding contributions or provided extraordinary service to athletics in the Penn Manor School District while serving as an athletic coach or as part of the athletic staff. The time period since completing his/her coaching/service has been at least five (5) years, or the staff members' duration of service has extended to a minimum of five (5) years.

Honors

1. The Committee may recommend to the Superintendent that the nominee be elected into the Penn Manor Athletic Wall of Honor. The nominee shall be elected to the Athletic Wall of Honor if the Superintendent approves the Committee's recommendation.
2. The Committee may upon a two-thirds vote of the Committee recommend to the Superintendent that the nominee's jersey be retired. Upon approval of the Superintendent, the Board shall consider the recommendation. The honor of retiring the nominee's jersey must be approved by a majority of the Board present and voting. The honor of retiring a nominee's jersey will only be considered in extra-ordinary circumstances.
