	<p style="text-align: center;">206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT</p> <p>1. Purpose The Board directs that the assignment of student to classes and schools within this district be consistent with the proper education of students and best use of district resources.</p> <p>2. Authority Pol. 103 The Board shall determine periodically the school attendance areas of the district and shall expect the students within each area to attend the school so designated. In assigning students to schools within this district, no distinction whatever shall be made on the basis of the student's race or color.</p> <p>3. Delegation of Responsibility The Superintendent shall periodically review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board changes that may be justified by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Considerations of safe student transportation and travel. 2. Financial and administrative efficiency. 3. Effectiveness of the instructional program. <p>The Superintendent may assign a student to a school other than that designated in the attendance area when such exception is justified by circumstances and is in the proper educational interest of the student.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall assign incoming transfer students to schools, grades, and classes that afford each student the greatest likelihood of realizing fullest educational potential.</p> <p>The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs and abilities of the student as well as the administration of the school.</p>
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
