212. REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS	
1. Purpose Pol. 216	The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the whole child. The Board acknowledges its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and progress in school and also recognizes the effects of State Board and federal regulations governing school records.
2. Authority	The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress which shall require all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility and which shall include academic progress reports, report cards, and parent conferences with teachers.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent, in conjunction with appropriate staff members, shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents and guardians.
4. Guidelines	Both student and parent shall receive ample warning of a pending grade of failure, or one that would adversely affect the student's status. Report cards shall be issued at intervals of not less than nine (9) weeks.
