| <p>1. Purpose</p>                      | <p>The Board recognizes that compulsory attendance laws impose on the Board the custodianship of district students while they are present in school.</p>   |
| <p>2. Delegation of Responsibility</p> | <p><u>Detentions</u></p> <p>When the police or juvenile authorities take a student into custody at school, the principal shall inform the Superintendent. The Superintendent or his/her designee may inform the student's parents, at an appropriate time, in cooperation with the police or juvenile authorities.</p> <p>No student shall be released to police or juvenile authorities without proper authorization, except in the event of emergency or for the protection of life or property, as determined by the principal.</p> |
