	238. PARENT-OF-RECORD
1. Purpose	It shall be the policy of the district that a student shall not be released from school to the care of a non-custodial parent unless the custodial parent consents to the release or the non-custodial parent presents to the principal a court order authorizing such a release.
2. Guidelines	<p>The district shall presume that parents share rights/custody unless evidence is presented to the contrary. Following are four (4) terms generally used in this area:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <u>Legal Custody</u> bestows the right to major educational decisions.2. <u>Physical Custody</u> either granted by the court or separate agreement or simply in fact.3. <u>Shared Custody</u> equal rights to deal with child.4. <u>Sole Custody</u> a judge's order would so state. <p><u>School Records</u></p> <p>Both parents shall have access to school records unless a court officially states otherwise. This is so regardless of custody status.</p>
