325. DRESS AND GROOMING	
1. Authority	<p>Administrative, professional and support employees set an example in dress and grooming for students and the school community. Employees' dress should reflect their professional status and encourage respect for authority in order to have a positive influence on the district's programs and operations.</p>
SC 510	<p>The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming requirements, within law, for all district employees to prevent an adverse impact on the educational programs and district operations.</p> <p>When assigned to district duties, employees shall be physically clean, neat, well-groomed and dressed in a manner consistent with assigned job responsibilities.</p> <p>Employees shall be groomed so that their hair style does not cause a safety or health hazard.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>If an employee feels that an exception to this policy would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the Superintendent or designee.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations and procedures for the implementation of this policy.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
