	<p style="text-align: center;">810.2. CAMERA SURVEILLANCE</p> <p>1. Authority</p> <p>The Board establishes that the rules of the district apply to each student during the time spent in travel to and from school, while occupying a school bus and while participating in school-related activities.</p> <p>The Board may place video cameras or other recording devices which may or may not be monitored, hereafter referred to as devices, on school property and/or on vehicles used for the transportation of students, employees and chaperones involved in school-related activities.</p> <p>2. Guidelines</p> <p>The images recorded by these devices may be used by the administration to determine whether conduct occurred which is contrary to the rules of the district or unlawful conduct and the extent of such conduct. They also may be used to establish the identity or identities of the particular student or students, employee or employees, contractor or contractor's employees and members of the general public involved in such conduct.</p> <p>The images recorded by these devices shall be admissible into evidence at any disciplinary proceeding conducted by the school district.</p> <p>At the discretion of the Superintendent, the images recorded by these devices may be provided to any appropriate law enforcement agency.</p> <p>All video archives created are the property of the school district and are to be used by the district as it deems appropriate. Students, parents/guardians, employees and others may obtain these tapes by the use of the legal process.</p> <p><u>Public Notice</u></p> <p>If the district utilizes video recording devices, notices may be posted at appropriate locations to notify students, parents/guardians, employees and members of the public that the district monitors conduct by recording devices such as video cameras.</p>

This notice is provided so that people do not have a false expectation of privacy while on school property, in school vehicles, or while participating in a school-related activity. The notices do not need to identify the location of devices.

Locker Rooms And Rest Rooms

The district will not place recording equipment in locker rooms or rest rooms unless there is a particular need for surveillance in those areas.

If such a need arises, the placement of such equipment should occur only after review by the Superintendent of the particular need for the use of such equipment and the development of appropriate controls concerning access to the recorded images.
