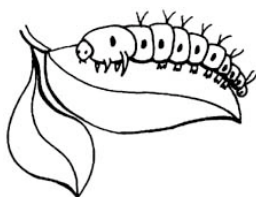
Which Came First? The Chicken or the Egg?

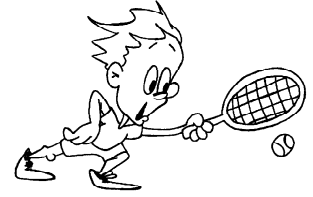
Be a Star!

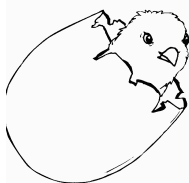
