115. CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

1. Authority SC 1806, 1807 Title 22 Sec. 4.31, 12.41, 339.2 The Board shall provide a program of career and technical education in order to:

- 1. Prepare students for employment as skilled workers or technicians in recognized, new and emerging occupations.
- 2. Prepare students for enrollment in postsecondary education programs.
- 3. Assist students in choosing career pathways.

All students participating in career and technical programs sponsored or supervised by the Board shall be considered regularly enrolled in district schools and shall be subject to Board policies and district administrative regulations and rules.

SC 1807, 1841 Title 22 Sec. 4.31, 339.2 The Board shall support a program of career and technical education which may include district students attending Lancaster County Career & Technology Center for participation in a cooperative program of career development.

SC 1850.1 Title 22 Sec. 4.31, 12.41, 339.21 Students and parents/guardians shall be informed that admission to career and technical education programs is accessible to regularly enrolled district students, in accordance with established criteria for attendance.
