137.1-AR. COCURRICULAR PARTICIPATION BY HOME EDUCATION STUDENTS

Cocurricular Activities

Students enrolled in a home education program who meet all the conditions stated in Board policy will be eligible to participate in the following district cocurricular activities:

- 1. School organizations.
- 2. Class organizations.
- 3. Clubs and societies.
- 4. Musical ensembles.
- 5. Theatrical organizations.
- 6. School publications.
- 7. Debating.
- 8. Forensics.
- 9. Other activities related to the school program.

Interscholastic Athletics

Students enrolled in a home education program who meet all the conditions stated in Board policy will be eligible to participate in the district's program of interscholastic athletics, including varsity sports and all activities related to competitive sports contests, games, events and exhibitions involving students or teams of students when such activities occur between schools within the school district or between schools outside of the school district.

When the district provides to district students a physical examination or medical test required for participation in an interscholastic athletic program, the district will provide the same opportunity to students enrolled in a home education program.

The district will publish in a publication of general circulation and on the district's web site the dates and times for physical examinations and medical tests required for participation in an interscholastic athletic program.
