The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you that as a parent/guardian of a student who has been a victim of a violent criminal offense you have the right to request a transfer to another school within our district, including a public charter school.

Federal law requires that all parents/guardians of students in this school be offered an opportunity to transfer their children to another eligible district school or charter. You have the right to request that your child be transferred to a safe public school, but your child is not required to transfer to another school. If you elect to request a transfer, such transfers would take effect on \_\_\_\_\_ (Date).
