223-AR-1. USE OF BICYCLES

Administrative regulations governing the use of bicycles by students on district property are based on considerations for the safety of students and others, protection against damage to district property, and possible district liability.

Registration forms for bicycle use can be obtained in the main office of the school.

Each student who registers and receives permission to ride a bicycle to school will receive a copy of the following regulations, which will be strictly enforced:

1. Each year the student must complete a registration form requesting to ride a bicycle to school. The form must be signed by the parent/guardian and approved by the building principal.
2. Students riding bicycles on school property will only ride on the school's roadways, not on sidewalks or walkways. Students will walk bicycles in those areas.
3. Students will park bicycles only in designated bicycle racks on school property.
4. Students are prohibited from riding bicycles on school property during normal school hours.
5. Excessive tardies will result in the loss of bicycle riding privileges.
6. Students must obey all township and borough ordinances and state laws regarding use of bicycles.
7. Bicycle privileges can be revoked at the discretion of the administration for violations of Board policy, school rules and regulations, with written notice sent to the parents/guardians.
