Senior Citizen Passes

Applicants for a senior citizens pass must be at least sixty (60) years of age or older and a resident of the district.

Applicants must apply at the district administration office and provide their name, address, telephone number and proof of age. Each approved individual will be given one (1) card/pass, which is not transferable.

Senior citizens passes may be used for free general admission to any district home athletic events excluding playoffs, selected plays and musical productions, adult education programs, and other district programs.

For an event where the sale of tickets is limited by seat capacity, the senior citizen must present the pass for a free ticket prior to the performance date. Without a reserved seat, there will be no assurance of a seat.

For participation in an adult education program, the senior citizen must present the pass at the time of registration for the program. The cost of books and materials will be the responsibility of the participant.

Availability of the senior citizens pass program will be publicized in district newsletters, on the district website, at senior citizens organizations, and in local newspapers.
