The dinner menu will include chicken pot pie, green beans, pepper cabbage and dessert, all served family-style in the cafeteria by Penn Manor High School students.


Dinner reservations are required.

Property tax rebate program available for senior citizens

Penn Manor School District has raised the income limit for senior citizens to qualify for rebates of up to \$650 on their school property taxes. Seniors also may qualify for a state rebate of up to \$975 on property taxes or rent payments from the previous year. The program benefits residents age 65 or older, widows and widowers age 50 or older and people with disabilities who are 18 or older.

Under the program, the school district has refunded more than \$200,000 to taxpayers over the past five years.

To qualify, homeowners must earn no more than \$35,000 to apply for the state rebate and \$25,000 to apply for the Penn Manor rebate. The school district's cutoff previously was \$15,000. There also is a state rebate program for renters earning no more than \$15,000.

When calculating total income, applicants should include 50 percent of Social Security income and 100 percent of other income types. Spouses, personal representatives or estates also may file rebate claims on behalf of claimants who lived at least one day in the previous year. The maximum standard rebate is \$650, but supplemental rebates for homeowners can boost the amount of the state rebate to \$975.

Applicants must first qualify for a state rebate before applying for a Penn Manor property tax rebate. Applications are currently being accepted for tax bills issued on July 1, 2017.
