The Penn Manor School Board met at 5:45 p.m. for a public workshop presented by the Counseling Department. At 6:45 p.m. the Board met for an Executive Session to discuss Personnel (Leaves, Resignation, and Retirement) and a Special Education Legal matter.

The Penn Manor School Board met as a Committee of the Whole at 7:13 p.m. in the boardroom at Manor Middle School. The meeting was called to order by Board President Mr. Carlton Rintz. Mr. Rintz announced that the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors of the Penn Manor School District will be held on Monday, November 2, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Rintz asked if there were any additions or corrections to the Minutes of the October 5, 2020, Committee of the Whole Meeting. Mr. Rintz asked for any Citizen Comments. The Board Secretary received six letters regarding the student attendance schedule. Three letters voiced support for having students in the school building five days per week. Three letter supported the current hybrid schedule. All letters are available for the public to read. Mrs. Lauren Troop addressed the board and voiced her support in favor of continuing the hybrid schedule. Ms. Evelyn Weaver, a PMHS senior, expressed her concern with the safety for students and staff if students fully return to school.

The board opportunities were reviewed. Dr. Fullerton attended the Agriculture Advisory Meeting on October 7. The district received \$55,000 in grants for the Ag department. PDE will evaluate our Ag program this year. Evaluations are done every five years. Dr. Fullerton also shared that the early intervention funding will be ending at the end of this year. He encouraged the board to write to their legislatures. Dr. Frerichs encouraged the board to complete the PSBA survey prior to the end of the month.

Mr. Reisinger and Mr. Billman updated the board on district cyber security practices and current threats to staff and student digital security and privacy.

Dr. Leichliter, Dr. Egan and Dr. Gale presented an update regarding ongoing equity work. Dr. Leichliter reviewed a working definition of "equity" in relation to the board goal for 2020-2021 for board input. Dr. Egan and Dr. Gale highlighted projects related to equity in the district.

Mr. Johnston presented the annual athletic reporting update. School districts are required to annually submit information to PDE by October 30th of each year regarding Interscholastic Athletic Opportunities and treatment for male and female secondary school students. This information will be posted on the district's website.

Dr. Leichliter provided the Superintendent's report. He thanked the community, students, and teachers at the high school for their patience during the recent shutdown. He asked Chris Johnston to review the latest bond refinancing. Mr. Johnston reported that he was informed on Friday morning that rates had hit the strike point for bond refinancing. The district exercised the option to refinance and will realize a savings of approximately \$540,000.
